	<p>For tinctures and extracts containing ethanol, the appropriate labelling for ethanol, taken from the 'Guideline on excipients in the label and package leaflet of medicinal products for human use', must be included.</p> <p>Indication 1)</p> <p>The use in children under 4 years of age has not been established due to lack of adequate data.</p> <p>Indication 2)</p> <p>The use in children under 12 years of age has not been established due to lack of adequate data.</p> <p>Indication 1)</p> <p>If the symptoms worsen during the use of the medicinal product or if dyspnoea, high fever or purulent sputum occurs, a doctor or a qualified health care practitioner should be consulted.</p>
